

Victory Christian Academy: K-12 Christian Education. In 2001, the vision for what would become Victory Christian Academy began to be realized. Local students, parents, pastors, and others in the Christian community shared a common desire for a Christ-centered educational alternative in the El Dorado area. Through a variety of surveys, meetings, and the abundant grace of God, the hopes of many coalesced into a concerted effort. In September 2002, Victory Christian Academy's first school year began in the old church building (formerly the El Dorado House of Prayer) which stood at the corner of Atchison and Pine. For the 2003-2004 school year, Victory Christian Academy was moved to its present home at 115 South Star (formerly the Christian Life Center for First Baptist Church and, originally, the El Dorado Civic Auditorium). Although curriculum has expanded, facilities changed, and the numbers of both students and teaching staff have more than doubled over the years, VCA continually strives to remain immovable on that one true foundation, Jesus Christ.
