Village Church Planting, Liberia, West Africa - OMS

First Baptist Church, El Dorado, began its involvement with Village Church Planting in Liberia in December 2006/January 2007. Church planting is truly the New Testament pattern for advancing the Kingdom, and the apostle Paul is the consummate church planter. We at First Baptist are privileged to be a part of this church planting movement in Liberia, as first generation, second generation, third generation churches and beyond are being established.

The country coordinator for this work in Liberia is Reverend Sam Greene. The village church planting trainers are Abraham Pantoe, Bai Anderson, Varney Freeman, and Richard Roberts. Each of these four men have recruited 10-15 pastors or “men of peace” who are planting first-generation churches in villages across Liberia. These churches are planting second-generation churches, and those in turn will plant others. The provision of motorbikes for each of the four trainers has greatly facilitated reaching into remote villages, as many are brought to Christ and disciplined in the faith.



FBC has also been a vital part of providing for physical needs for food and shelter of the people in these churches. Bibles have been provided, and much prayer support and encouragement have been given. Those who have gone on mission from here to there return with changed lives. Continue to pray the Lord of the harvest for His outpouring through this work.
